Tyne & Wear Young Volunteers Project

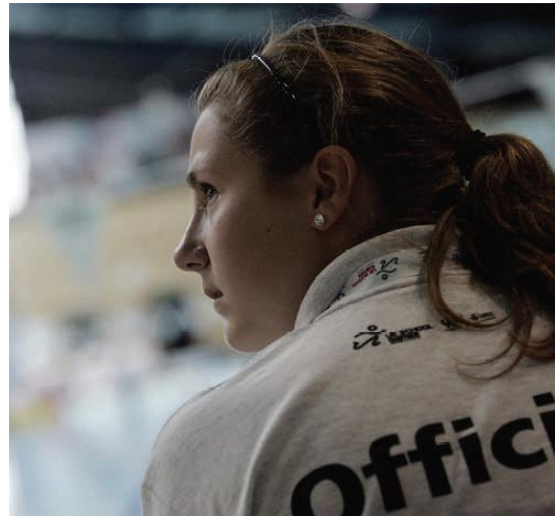
